

Weekender 2025 // Ticket Prize draw rules

1. Eligibility

- The competition is open to legal residents of the UK who are aged 16 or older.
- Employees, trustees, elders and representatives of Clarendon Trust, as well as their immediate family members (spouse, parents, siblings, and children), are not eligible to participate.

2. Entry Requirement

- To enter the competition, participants must book at least one ticket for The Weekender 2025. The ticket purchase will automatically qualify the participant for entry into the prize draw.

3. Entry Period

- Bookings must be completed by midnight GMT, 31st October 2024 for entry into the prize draw.
- One entry per booking qualifies for the prize draw.

4. How to Enter

- Participants will be automatically entered into the prize draw when they book a ticket through weareemmanuel.com/weekender
- No additional steps are required beyond purchasing the ticket.

5. Prize

- Free camping admission ticket for 1 booking and free accommodation ticket for 1 booking, for the Weekender 2025.
- The prize is non-transferable and there is no cash alternative.
- The prize is only valid for the Weekender 2025.

6. Selection and Notification of Winner

- The method of selecting the winner will be a random draw.
- The winner will be contacted via email following the draw on 5th November 2024 and will be required to provide bank details to refund the value of their booking.
- The winner has 14 days to respond to claim their prize.
